The meetings will be open to UN organizations and admitted intergovernmental organizations in accordance with the above-mentioned decision. In accordance with decision 23/CP.18 and guided by the Enhanced Lima Work Programme on Gender (7/CP.29) and the Belém Gender Action Plan, the UNFCCC secretariat encourages the nomination of women participants with a view to achieving gender balance and informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally.

Owing to space limitations, access may be limited for in-person participation. Participation will only be confirmed after the registration deadline. However, the meetings will be webcast through the UNFCCC website. The deadline for registering as an observer for the meetings is on **Friday, 13 March 2026** at 6 p.m. Central European Time. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the meetings as early as possible, observer registrations received after this deadline may not be processed.
