Pursuant to decisions 13/CP.28, 4/CMP.18 and 19/CMA.5, I am pleased to notify United Nations system and specialized agencies and other relevant organizations, and intergovernmental organizations admitted as observers that the 14<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) will take place **in Bonn, Germany, on Thursday, 4 June and Friday, 5 June 2026.**

Nominations of representatives received from other persons or organizations will need to be endorsed by their respective DCPs.

The deadline for registration as an observer(s) for the meeting is **Thursday, 30 April 2026**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, the secretariat may not be able to process observer registrations received after this deadline.
