The Global Dialogue on impacts of the implementation of response measures 9-10 September 2024

I am pleased to invite United Nations and related organizations and specialized agencies (UN organizations) and admitted intergovernmental organizations to participate in the mandated global dialogue on the impacts of the implementation of response measures. The global dialogue is organized pursuant to Decision 13/CP.28, Decision 4/CMP.18, and Decision 19/CMA.5 in a hybrid format, allowing for both in-person and virtual participation.

The dialogue is scheduled to take place from **9 to 10 September 2024** in a hybrid format, with the in-person element taking place in Accra, Ghana. The event will be hosted by the Government of Ghana and organized by the UNFCCC. The dialogue will coincide with the three-day 11th meeting of the Katowice Committee on Impacts, scheduled for **11-13 September 2024**.
