Please visit the air travel carbon emissions calculator at <www.icao.int/environmental-protection/CarbonOffset/Pages/default.aspx> to calculate the climate footprint of your travel. Secondly, you are also encouraged to compensate for your climate footprint by cancelling the corresponding number of offsets through UNFCCC's voluntary cancellation platform at <offset.climateneutralnow.org>. Should you be travelling by train or car, we propose that you compensate for your emissions by cancelling one Certified Emission Reduction (one tonne of offset) at the voluntary cancellation platform.

In accordance with the Conference of the Parties decision 23/CP.18, and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the needs of women and men equally, you are kindly encouraged to nominate women participants to attend the twenty-first meeting of the SCF.
