7–24 September 2021

I am pleased to notify United Nations organizations and admitted observer intergovernmental organizations (IGOs) that the **14th meeting of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts** will take place between 7 and 24 September 2021 (discontinuously, in approximately eight live sessions of two hours each). Owing to travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it will be held in a virtual format.

The meeting will be open to attendance by admitted observer organizations in accordance with decision 2/CP.20, paragraph 14.
