

OVERVIEW OF THE SCOPE OF WORK ON SLOW ONSET EVENTS

Mandate: Activity 1 (b) of the strategic workstream (a) “Enhanced cooperation and facilitation in relation to slow onset events (SOEs)” of the 5-year workplan, involves assessing the scope of work being undertaken on SOEs as reported by partners in the SOEs database.

Approach: A detailed paper provides a regional analysis of the scope of work of the 164 organizations that are part of the SOEs database. The poster highlights the key findings of the paper. The information provided is based on the SOE database as of February 2018.



Mapping of the number of organizations working on SOEs by region and function area

Drawing upon decision 3/CP. 18, the SOEs database categorizes the scope of work in seven areas of action. For the purpose of the analysis, the seven areas of action were clustered into the three function areas of the Warsaw International Mechanism (F1, F2, and F3).
