PAKISTAN'S VULNERABILITY TO CLIMATE CHANGE THREATS

Considerable increase in frequency and intensity of extreme weather events causing huge losses since 2009

* Projected recession of Hindu Kush-Karakoram-Himalayan (HKH) glaciers due to global warming

Increased siltation of major dams caused by more frequent and intense floods

CONTINUE...

- * Increased temperature resulting in enhanced heat- and water-stressed conditions, particularly in arid and semi-arid regions, leading to reduced agriculture productivity. Increased health risks and climate change induced migration.
- ➤ Decrease in the forest cover from too rapid change in climatic conditions.

* Increased intrusion of saline water in the Indus delta, adversely affecting coastal agriculture, mangroves and breeding grounds of fish

* Parliament of Pakistan has adopted the SDGs as Pakistan's SDGs. Ministry of Planning is focal institution to coordinate with relevant ministries for implementation of SDGs.
