## I. Opening of the session

1. The fiftieth session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) was held at the World Conference Center Bonn in Bonn, Germany, from 17 to 27 June 2019.
2. The Chair of the SBI, Emmanuel Dumisani Dlamini (Eswatini), opened the session on Monday, 17 June, and welcomed all Parties and observers. He informed the SBI that the SBI Vice-Chair, Naser Moghaddasi (Iran (Islamic Republic of)), could not be present at this session, and that the Rapporteur, Aysin Turpanci (Turkey), would be arriving later during the session.
