Status of contributions as at 31 May 2019

Note by the secretariat

Summary

Total indicative contributions for 2019 as per decision 21/CP.23 amount to EUR 27,433,860, of which EUR 23,318,781 relates to the Convention and EUR 4,115,079 to the Kyoto Protocol. As at 31 May 2019, the outstanding contributions for 2019 amounted to EUR 13,013,939 (EUR 5,202,881 for 2018); the total outstanding contributions for 2010–2019 were EUR 21,349,775, of which EUR 18,776,875 related to the Convention and EUR 2,572,819 to the Kyoto Protocol. For 1996–2009, USD 183,563 remained outstanding.

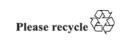
A total of 128 Parties had not made their contributions in full for 2019 for the Convention (81 for 2018) and 122 for the Kyoto Protocol (75 for 2018).

In the biennium 2018–2019, voluntary contributions amounting to USD 41,470,794 have been received by the Trust Fund for Supplementary Activities and USD 8,224,056 by the Trust Fund for Participation in the UNFCCC Process.

- 1. This document contains information on the status of receipt of contributions to the UNFCCC trust funds as at 31 May 2019 and measures taken by the secretariat to address the level of outstanding contributions to the Trust Fund for the Core Budget of the UNFCCC. The status of contributions for the Kyoto Protocol is reported separately from the status of contributions for the Convention.
- 2. <u>Table 1</u> lists all 197 Parties to the Convention and shows the expected and received contributions during 2019 and the outstanding balances for 2019 and previous years in euros due to the Trust Fund for the Core Budget of the UNFCCC (for the Convention). As at 31 May 2019 a total of 69 Parties have paid their contributions for 2019, and 51.5 per cent of the indicative contributions for the year have been received. In <u>table 2</u>, Parties are grouped according to their status of contributions paid to the core budget for the Convention. <u>Table 3</u> presents the outstanding contributions for 1996–2009 in United States dollars.

- 3. Table 4 lists all 192 Parties to the Kyoto Protocol and shows the expected and received contributions during 2019 and the outstanding balances for 2019 and previous years in euros due to the Trust Fund for the Core Budget of the UNFCCC (for the Kyoto Protocol). As at 31 May 2019 a total of 70 Parties have paid their contributions for 2019, and 70.2 per cent of the indicative contributions for the year have been received. In table 5, Parties are grouped according to their status of contributions paid to the core budget for the Kyoto Protocol. Table 6 presents the outstanding contributions for 2005–2009 in United States dollars.
- 4. <u>Table 7</u> lists the seven Parties that have not paid any contributions to the Trust Fund for the Core Budget of the UNFCCC, with their outstanding contributions amounting to EUR 35,072 for 2010–2019 and USD 26,562 for 1996–2009.
- 5. The President of the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-third session wrote letters to 100 Parties on their outstanding contributions, of which 32 Parties paid their outstanding contributions by 31 December 2017 and 51 Parties by 31 December 2018. The working capital reserve in the core budget (EUR 2,372,575) was fully funded as at 31 December 2018, as a result of Parties settling their outstanding contributions for previous bienniums. The secretariat continued to explore suitable collaborative measures, such a payment plans, for addressing Parties' outstanding contributions in 2018; and the intensive efforts to follow up on Parties' outstanding contributions will continue in 2019 onward.
- 6. A report of the Secretary-General on improving the financial situation of the United Nations to the General Assembly¹ details measures for addressing the liquidity and broader structural problems that constrain budget management at the United Nations Secretariat, including the Secretary-General's request for the General Assembly to increase the Working Capital Fund. Similarly, the secretariat invites the Subsidiary Body for Implementation to consider the following measures for addressing the ongoing cash flow issues of the UNFCCC:
 - (a) Reviewing the level of the working capital reserve;
- (b) Requesting support from the regional groups in encouraging Parties to settle their outstanding contributions;
- (c) Approving, on an exceptional basis, a write-off of the indicative contributions for 1996–2009 to the core budget for the Convention and the Kyoto Protocol in the amount of USD 183,563 as per table 8.
- 7. The status of payment of fees for the international transaction log is shown in <u>table 9</u>. As at 31 May 2019, eight Parties had outstanding fees for 2019, representing 28.5 per cent of the international transaction log budget for the year.
- 8. <u>Table 10</u> presents the voluntary contributions, amounting to USD 41.5 million, received in the biennium 2018–2019 by the Trust Fund for Supplementary Activities. <u>Table 11</u> shows voluntary contributions to the Trust Fund for Participation in the UNFCCC Process, which amounted to USD 8.2 million as at 31 May 2019.
- 9. The various fees paid towards the clean development mechanism are listed in <u>table 12</u>, which amounted to USD 16.1 million as at 31 May 2019.
