National adaptation plans

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the reports¹ on progress in the process to formulate and implement national adaptation plans (NAPs) and took note of the other relevant documents² prepared for the session.
2. The SBI welcomed the information provided by the Adaptation Committee and the Least Developed Countries Expert Group³ on gaps and needs related to the process to formulate and implement NAPs.⁴
3. The SBI considered actions and steps necessary to initiate the next assessment of progress in the process to formulate and implement NAPs, to take place no later than in 2025, noting plans for the first global stocktake.⁵ The SBI recommended a draft decision on this matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-sixth session (for the text of the draft decision, see document FCCC/SBI/2021/L.11/Add.1).
4. The SBI initiated consideration of information from the reports of the Adaptation Committee and the Least Developed Countries Expert Group, including on gaps and needs and the implementation of NAPs.⁶ It decided to continue its consideration of this matter at SBI 56 (June 2022) on the basis of the draft text elements prepared by the co-facilitators for this agenda item,⁷ with a view to recommending a draft decision on this matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-seventh session (November 2022).
