## Gender and climate change

## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) initiated the intermediate review of the progress of implementation of the activities contained in the gender action plan of the enhanced Lima work programme on gender.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. The SBI took note of the rich exchange of views among Parties and the proposals made by them on this matter at this session.
- 3. The SBI welcomed the progress in relation to this matter and agreed to continue consideration thereof at its fifty-seventh session (November 2022) taking note of the informal notes prepared by the co-facilitators for this agenda item at this session under their own responsibility,<sup>2</sup> with a view to recommending a draft decision thereon for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-seventh session (November 2022).
