

First periodic assessment referred to in paragraph 69 of decision 1/CP.21

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation welcomed the efforts of the secretariat to prepare the final report on the first periodic assessment¹ of the effectiveness and adequacy of the support provided to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement on matters relating to technology development and transfer.²
- 2. It noted that the outcomes of the first periodic assessment should serve as an input to the global stocktake referred to in Article 14 of the Paris Agreement and guide improved effectiveness of and enhanced support to the Technology Mechanism in supporting the implementation of the Paris Agreement.³
- 3. The SBI recommended a draft decision on this matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its fourth session (November 2022) (see document FCCC/SBI/2022/L.27/Add.1).
