I. Introduction

1. On 4 June 2023, the secretariat received a request from Cuba on behalf of the Group of 77 and China to include an item in the provisional agenda for the fifty-eighth session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI).¹
2. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the Chair of the SBI, this matter has been included in the supplementary provisional agenda as item 22.
