Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) initiated the final review of the implementation of the enhanced Lima work programme on gender and its gender action plan, starting with consideration of the work programme.
- 2. The SBI agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBI 61 (November 2024) on the basis of the draft text prepared for this agenda item at this session² with a view to recommending a draft decision thereon for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-ninth session (November 2024).
