I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

- 1. The sixty-first session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) was held at Baku Stadium in Baku, Azerbaijan, from 11 to 16 November 2024.
- 2. The Chair of the SBI, Nabeel Munir (Pakistan), opened the session and welcomed all Parties and observers. He also welcomed Gonzalo Guaiquil (Chile) as Vice-Chair and Ayşin Turpanci (Türkiye) as Rapporteur.



Adoption of the agenda

(Agenda sub-item 2(a))

- 3. At its 1st meeting, on 11 November, the SBI considered a note by the Executive Secretary containing the supplementary provisional agenda. The Chair recalled the understanding reached among Parties outlined at the 1st meeting, on 11 November, of the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-ninth session, which applies mutatis mutandis to the SBI, and proposed that the supplementary provisional agenda be amended to reflect this understanding, with item 19 deleted.
- 4. The Chair also recalled that the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at the 1st meeting, on 11 November, of its sixth session referred consideration of matters under its agenda item 8, entitled "Reporting and review

pursuant to Article 13 of the Paris Agreement: provision of financial and technical support to developing country Parties for reporting and capacity-building", to the SBI³ and proposed that the matter be considered under an equally titled item, with the subsequent items retaining the numbers and titles in the supplementary provisional agenda.

- 5. As proposed by the Chair, the SBI adopted the agenda as follows:⁴

 - (c) Summary reports on the technical analysis of biennial update reports of Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention;
 - (d) Report of the Consultative Group of Experts.
