I. Introduction

1. On 3 June 2025 the secretariat received two requests from the Plurinational State of Bolivia on behalf of the Like-minded Developing Countries (LMDCs) to include two items in the provisional agenda for the sixty-second session of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI).¹
2. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the Chair of the SBI, these matters have been included in the supplementary provisional agenda as items 20 and 21.
