Matters relating to the least developed countries

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the report on the 48th meeting of the Least Developed Countries Expert Group,¹ held in Lusaka from 18 to 20 August 2025.
2. The SBI considered the steps for the stocktake of the work of the Least Developed Countries Expert Group mandated to take place at the thirty-first session of the Conference of the Parties (November 2026) and the eighth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (November 2026), the midway point before the review of the mandate of the Group at the thirty-sixth session of the Conference of the Parties (2031).²
3. The SBI recommended draft decisions on this matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its thirtieth session and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its seventh session (for the text of the draft decisions, see document FCCC/SBI/2025/L.18/Add.1–2).
