Status of contributions and fees as at 15 May 2026

Note by the secretariat

Summary

Total core budget contributions for 2026 as per decision [20/CP.30](#) amount to EUR 41.1 million. As at 15 May 2026, the outstanding contributions for 2026 amounted to EUR 24.3 million, and 148 Parties had not made their contributions in full for 2026. Total outstanding contributions for prior years were EUR 15.8 million as at 15 May 2026.

Between 1 January and 15 May 2026, voluntary contributions amounting to USD 23.9 million were received by the trust fund for supplementary activities and USD 0.05 million by the trust fund for participation in the UNFCCC process.



1. This document contains information on the status of contributions to UNFCCC trust funds as at 15 May 2026.
2. Table 1 lists all Parties to the Convention and its Kyoto Protocol and shows the status of contributions to the trust fund for the core budget of the UNFCCC as at 15 May 2026. Total contributions to be paid by all Parties for 2026 amount to EUR 41.1 million pursuant to decision [20/CP.30](#) and based on the indicative scales of contributions for 2026–2027 contained in the decisions on administrative, financial and institutional matters adopted by the Conference of the Parties at its thirtieth session and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its twentieth session.¹ As at 15 May 2026, 39 per cent (EUR 16.8 million) of the contributions for 2026 had been received. Pursuant to the UNFCCC financial procedures,² the annual contributions to the core budget for 2026 were due on 1 January 2026. As at 15 May 2026, the outstanding contributions for 2026 amounted to EUR 24.3 million and 148 Parties had outstanding contributions for 2026 of more than EUR 50. For prior years the total outstanding contributions were EUR 15.8 million as at 15 May 2026.
3. There were no fees due or outstanding for the international transaction log as at 15 May 2026.
4. Table 2 shows the voluntary contributions to the trust fund for supplementary activities, amounting to USD 23.9 million, and table 3 shows the voluntary contributions to the trust fund for participation in the UNFCCC process, amounting to USD 0.05 million, received in 2026.
5. An overview of the fee-based income to the trust fund for the clean development mechanism in 2026, amounting to USD 0.1 million, is provided in table 4.
6. An overview of the fee-based income to the trust fund for the Paris Agreement crediting mechanism in 2026, amounting to USD 0.1 million, is provided in table 5.
