Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) noted the summary of the secretariat's cooperative activities with United Nations entities and other international organizations between May 2021 and April 2022.1
- The SBSTA welcomed the information event, held at this session, on the secretariat's cooperation with United Nations entities and other international organizations.
- The SBSTA noted the importance of the secretariat's cooperation, within the scope of existing mandates provided by the governing bodies, with relevant United Nations entities and other international organizations in relation to supporting Parties' efforts to enhance the ambition of their climate action, including with regard to mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation, and contributing to the implementation of the Paris Agreement and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

The SBSTA encouraged its Chair to continue to provide opportunities for Parties and stakeholders to exchange views on the progress of the secretariat's cooperative activities with United Nations entities and other international organizations and to provide guidance to the secretariat on this matter at future sessions.
