Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) considered options for conducting reviews on a voluntary basis of the information reported pursuant to decision 18/CMA.1, annex, chapter IV, and the respective training courses needed to facilitate these voluntary reviews, including the associated budgetary considerations.¹
2. The SBSTA noted with appreciation the views submitted² by Parties³ and those exchanged at the session on these matters.
3. The SBSTA agreed to continue its consideration of these matters at its fifty-seventh session (November 2022) on the basis of the draft text available on the UNFCCC website.⁴
