1. The fifty-seventh session of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) was held at the Sharm el-Sheikh International Convention Center in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt, from 6 to 12 November 2022.
2. The Chair of the SBSTA, Tosi Mpanu Mpanu (Democratic Republic of the Congo), opened the session on Sunday, 6 November, and welcomed all Parties and observers. He also welcomed Kakhaber Mdivani (Georgia) as Vice-Chair and Zita Kassa Wilks (Gabon) as Rapporteur.
