## Greenhouse gas data interface

## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) reaffirmed the importance of greenhouse gas (GHG) emission data being easily accessible in the GHG data interface.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. The SBSTA requested the secretariat to prepare a workplan for further developing the GHG data interface, incorporating data and information reported by Parties under the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement. The workplan shall be presented to Parties for their consideration at SBSTA 62 (June 2025).
- 3. The SBSTA agreed to continue consideration of this matter at SBSTA 62.
