Cooperation with other international organizations

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) welcomed the summary of the secretariat's cooperative activities with United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations since SBSTA 48.
- 2. The SBSTA also welcomed the special event at this session organized by the secretariat on its cooperation with United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations.
- 3. The SBSTA noted the importance of the secretariat's cooperation, within the scope of existing mandates provided by the governing bodies, with relevant United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations to supporting Parties' efforts to enhance ambition on climate actions, including with regard to mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation, and in contributing to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
- 4. The SBSTA recognized that the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Paris Agreement adopted under the Convention are the primary international, intergovernmental forums for negotiating the global response to climate change.
