Main features

- Respond to paragraph15 of Lima Call for Climate Action no country left behind
- Budget: 3.5 million euros. Capacity : Around 20 countries covered
- Targeted area: Africa & SIDS
- Short-term technical expertise and support
- Financed by Agence Française de Développement and implemented by Expertise France
- Coordination with other iNDC support programs



Main features

- **Demand-driven**: Facility activated upon formal request to French embassies in-country
- **Collaborative**: Technical assistance adapted to local needs
 - Deliverables to be reviewed and approved
 - Focus on country requirements
- Fast track: Rapid deployment of short-term technical expertise
- Quality assurance: transversal technical back up and inputs by senior experts



Implementation

- Timeline: February-October 2015
- Launch
 - Pre-identification of countries that could benefit of this facility based on existing support and a first need assement
 - Requests from countries received by local AFD agency
 - Terms of reference established
- Diagnosis support:
- Assessment of existing data, policies, strategies, plans, actions and programs
- Possible small additional studies (short delivering)



Implementation

- Institutional support:
 - Assist in developing mitigation potential projections and adaptation options
 - Help establishing iNDC core elements (priorities)
 - support organizing consultation sessions (ownership)
 - Provide support to iNDC technical team
- Drafting support:
 - Support delivery of draft iNDC outline
 - Support iNDC finalization, approval and submission
