

2014 biennial assessment and overview of climate finance flows (BA)



- ➤ The SCF conducted the 2014 Biennial Assessment and Overview of Climate Finance Flows (BA) to present a picture of climate finance to the extent possible, drawing on available sources of information on the geographical and thematic balance of flows.
- ➤ It reviewed the operational definitions of climate finance and reporting systems used by institutions that collect climate finance
- ➤ Thematic distribution of adaptation finance: The SCF reviewed thematic distribution of climate finance reported as FSF, in BRs, through multilateral climate funds, and through Multilateral Development Banks.
- Understanding adaptation impact: Methodologies for assessing impact on resilience and effective adaptation remain to be refined.





2016 biennial assessment and overview of climate finance flows (BA)

- ☐ The SCF considered at its 12th meeting initial material compiled from a wide range of available sources.
 - Up to date information on the harmonization of the operational definitions of climate finance and reporting approaches of data producers and aggregators
 - Better understanding of the variations in the methodological approaches used for data collection and aggregation
 - Where possible, presentation of trends on climate finance flows and the reasons behind them
 - To the extent possible, reflection on the recipient countries perspective
 - Information and data relevant to Article 2, paragraph 1(c) in the overview and assessment chapters.
- ☐ The SCF will include a summary and recommendations in it annual report to COP22.
- ☐ The 2016 BA will also inform the biennial high-level ministerial dialogue on climate finance
