Ulf Moslener is a member of the Standing Committee on Finance. He is Professor for Sustainable Energy Finance at the faculty of Frankfurt School of Finance and Management in Germany. As Head of Research of the UNEP Collaborating Centre for Climate and Sustainable Energy Finance his current fields of research are the economics of climate change, financing sustainable energy systems and climate finance.

He was deputy head of the department of “Environmental and Resource Economics and Environmental Management” at the Centre for European Economic Research (ZEW) in Mannheim, Germany. His main areas of interest were international climate policy, the analysis of carbon regulation, carbon emissions trading, and policy instruments to promote renewable energy.

Thereafter he joined KfW Development Bank, where he dealt with the practice of financing renewable energy and energy efficiency in developing and newly industrialized countries within the German development co-operation, in particular related to the German contribution to the Clean Technology Fund.

Ulf Moslener holds a Diploma in Physics and a PhD in economics from the University of Heidelberg.
