



# **UNEP Support to INDC Process**

- UNEP DTU is providing technical support to 30 countries under the GEF funded UNEP INDC Support Programme.
- UNEP DTU's Technical Assistance consist of:
- Defining the scope and nature of INDCs
  - The scope of work depends on the content (mitigation, adaptation, etc.
  - A stock tacking and country background analysis
  - Detailed scope of work including contents and nature of INDCs identified.





- Designing, organizing and conducting training sessions/workshops
  - Two workshops organized in Copenhagen:
    - 20-22 May 12 countries and 30 participants
    - 30 June 02 July 18 countries, more than 40 participants expected.





### Analytical support

- Common platform INDC national process to be consistent with UNFCCC process and with countries selected scope of work
- The purpose is to create a uniform understanding among all Parties of the INDC process and a common format for reporting INDC.
- This will enable a comparable technical analysis by the UNFCCC.





### Analytical support

- Technical analysis of the country's current circumstances on climate change
  - A stocktaking and analysis of current data and existing efforts to address climate change
  - A detailed stocktaking will be conducted by the national expert
  - Calculations and forecastings: GACMO; other models...
- Requirements for the phase UDP will implement the following activities:
  - Guidance manual to enable countries understand the INDC process and its requirements;
  - Technical manual for analysis and modelling tool (in case of countries confirm the use of the GACMO model under development by UDP)
  - Template for stock taking report of current country situation related to climate change
  - Templates for preparing and submitting the INDCs, and templates for final project report.

#### Output

Draft INDC report outlining various options for each of the elements of the INDCs.





- Support the political endorsement of the draft INDCs options
  - National consultation workshop
  - Support is provided for political approval
  - Support Final submission of INDCs to UNFCCC.





### In-Country Specific Technical Assistance.

- Direct support to undertake analysis (mitigation and adaptation)
- UNEP DTU works closely with the national consultant(s) to:
  - support identifying data needs and collection,
  - application of methodology for analysis (GACMO Model)
  - revision of analysis.
- Review all national activity outputs quality control; substance and consistency with UNFCCC requirements.
- Support in preparing and finalizing INDC report ready for political endorsement
