

Facilitated break out groups findings – Group II

What could be areas of interventions by the TEC, TM and other stakeholders?

- The TEC could continue its good work on south-south cooperation, and broaden the focus using also existing tools as a priority but also exploring other opportunities that could benefit south-south cooperation;
- The TEC could promote discussions, providing input to the COP, initiate cooperation amongst the relevant bodies, including the CTCN ;
- The CTCN could broaden its scope and maybe open a new window within the CTCN to pro-actively promote such collaborations, providing a seed fund to initiate collaborations, need to engage NDEs, linkage to the LEG to work with LDCs);
- The TEC in cooperation with the CTCN could involve industrialized countries, initiate a learning process that could contribute to building body of knowledge on adaptation technologies to serve as info resource for the developing countries;
- Triangular cooperation is considered very important and the TEC and the CTCN should explore a mechanism that would efficiently promote such cooperation, for example on early warning systems, climate observations;
- The quality component of technologies was considered important, the TEC could play monitoring and validation role;
- Enhance pier- to-pier cooperation, expertise, and experience exchange, using the existing Centers of Excellence as focal points;
- Look at success stories and design more comprehensive types of information based on them;
