Information on Visas

Foreigners must possess valid passports or similar documents and comply with the regulations contained in the Immigration Act B.E.2522 (1979) and its related provisions. Be aware that Thai visa requirements change from time to time and a Thai embassy in your home country can provide you with the most up to date Thailand visa information. Visa Exemptions

Approximately 40 nations qualify for a Thai visa exemption. Citizens of New Zealand, Australia, Canada, USA, and most European nations may enter Thailand for up to 30 days without a Thai visa.

Visa on Arrival

According to the Interior Ministerial Announcements, passport holders from 22 countries and

territories may apply for visas at the immigration checkpoints for the purpose of tourism for a period not exceeding 15 days.
