Key research gaps

- 1. Descarbonization processes: Commuters estimation, transportation emission estimation (vehicules kilometers travel -VKT), carbon absorption by urban forest
- Climate-related health issues: mortality and morbility by heat waves, cardiorespiratory disease, dengue
- 3. Urban forest and urban heat island
- 4. Soil permeability in relation to the reduction of runoff in heavy rain events and floods
- 5. Rising water table
