### **COUNTRY ENGAGEMENT**

The Country Engagement process is an adaptable five-step model to establish, operationalize, and track Partnership activities at the country level.

It provides a framework where member country needs are matched to the coordinated support of the Partnership's members and beyond.

#### **Rules of Engagement:**

- 1. Country driven
- 2. Cross-sectoral and multi-stakeholder process
- 3. Alignment with existing National Strategies and sectoral plans

### TECHNOLOGY NEEDS AND NDC IMPLEMENTATION ON COUNTRY LEVEL



### **EXAMPLES FROM COUNTRY ENGAGEMENT**

#### **Technology Needs requested by Focus Area and Sector**

Partnership Plan per Focus Area



Partnership Plan per Sector

\*Technology is classified as the application of scientific knowledge and tools for project implementation and captures technology transfer.



### **TECHNOLOGY NEEDS BY SECTORS**

#### Water and Waste Management



**Ethiopia:** Knowledge / Peer to peer exchange visit to learn about best practices in water efficiency technologies



**Jordan:** Design and construction of semi-mechanized waste sorting unit with capacity of 200 tons per day, which can be expanded.





## **TECHNOLOGY NEEDS BY SECTORS**

#### **Agriculture, Forest and other Land-use**



**Jordan:** Mechanize Technology for adaptation to climate change by strengthening the water and agricultural sectors.

#### (Supported by Sweden)



**Mozambique:** Strengthening the role of women producers as training and technology transfer agents.





### **TECHNOLOGY NEEDS BY SECTORS**

#### Energy



**Republic of the Marshall Islands:** Development of an Energy Roadmap that will focus on the electricity sector and potential electrification of the transport sector to ensure efforts reach out to 2030 with a view beyond that, while understanding that plans may change based on technological developments past 2030

(Supported by the World Bank Group)





# SUPPORT PROVIDED BY THE PARTNERSHIP

The countries received support for their Partnership Plans for technology related requests:

- **44.83 %** indicated support (FAO, World Bank and UNDP)
- 20.69 % are still under development (AFD, FAO ad CTCN)





## **COUNTRY ENGAGEMENT**

- 15 Partnership Plans approved by Government and under implementation
  - **39+ partners** delivering support working under single framework
  - Mainstreaming NDCs into governments national development plans and sectoral strategies
  - Changing the legal framework for NDC implementation
  - Developing domestic finance and accounting systems
  - **Preparing project** pipeline for GCF, World Bank on water, energy, transport, forestry, agriculture, waste
  - Improving data for NDC revision process
  - Strengthening national environmental funds
  - **Designing, establishing, and strengthening** climate governance and coordination mechanisms
  - Supporting NDC updating and enhancement
- 15 Partnership Plans to be completed in 2019

- Offer an organized set of **information resources and tools** to help countries learn how to access finance from diverse sources.
