 - Enhance technology cooperation for action on climate change
 - Facilitate knowledge sharing on climate technology
 - Establish links with existing knowledge platforms
 - Respond to the knowledge requirements of all users
 - Disseminate effectively the outputs of the TEC




The new TT:CLEAR

1. New TT:CLEAR homepage
