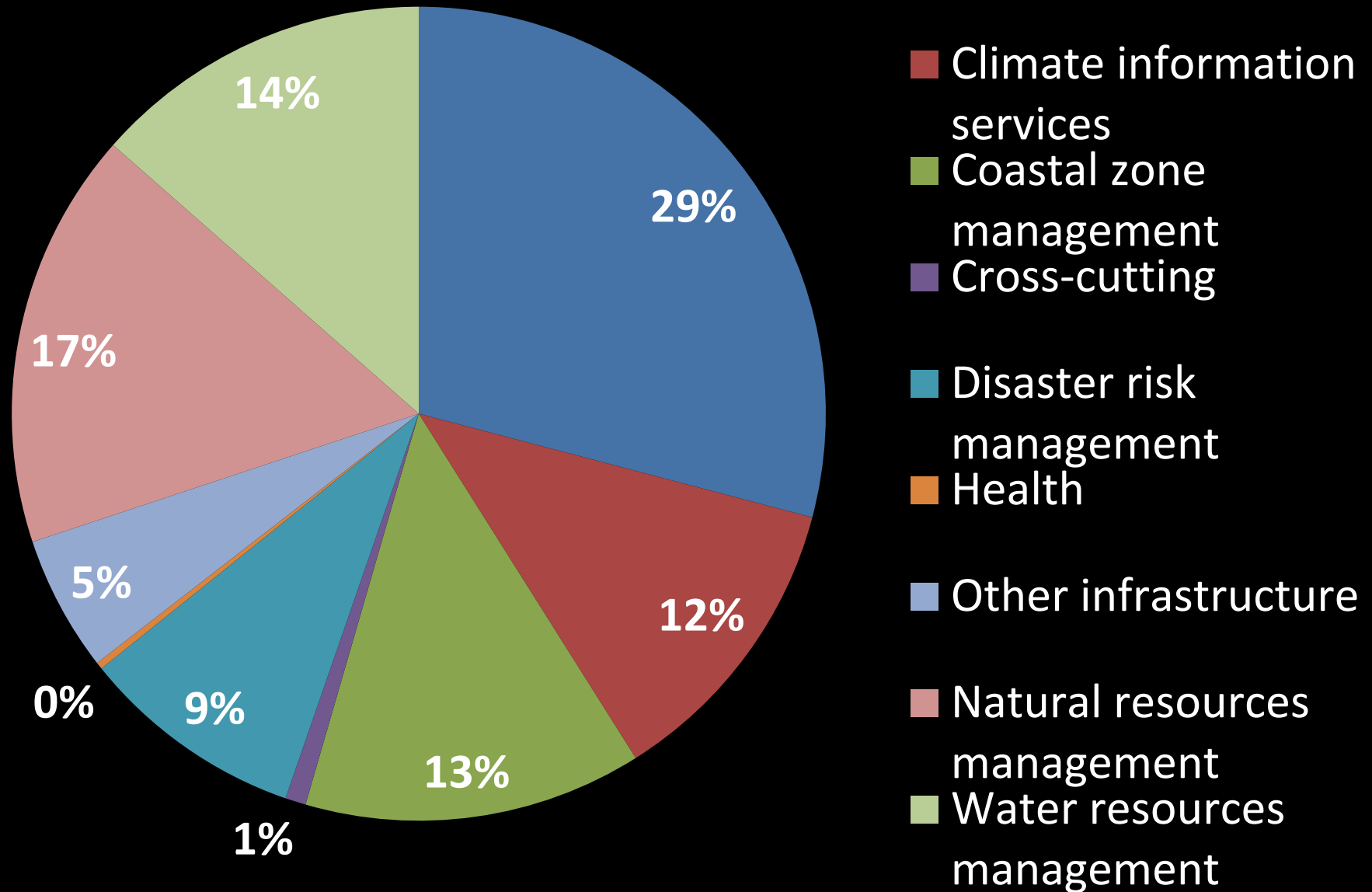

# GEF Adaptation Program at a glance

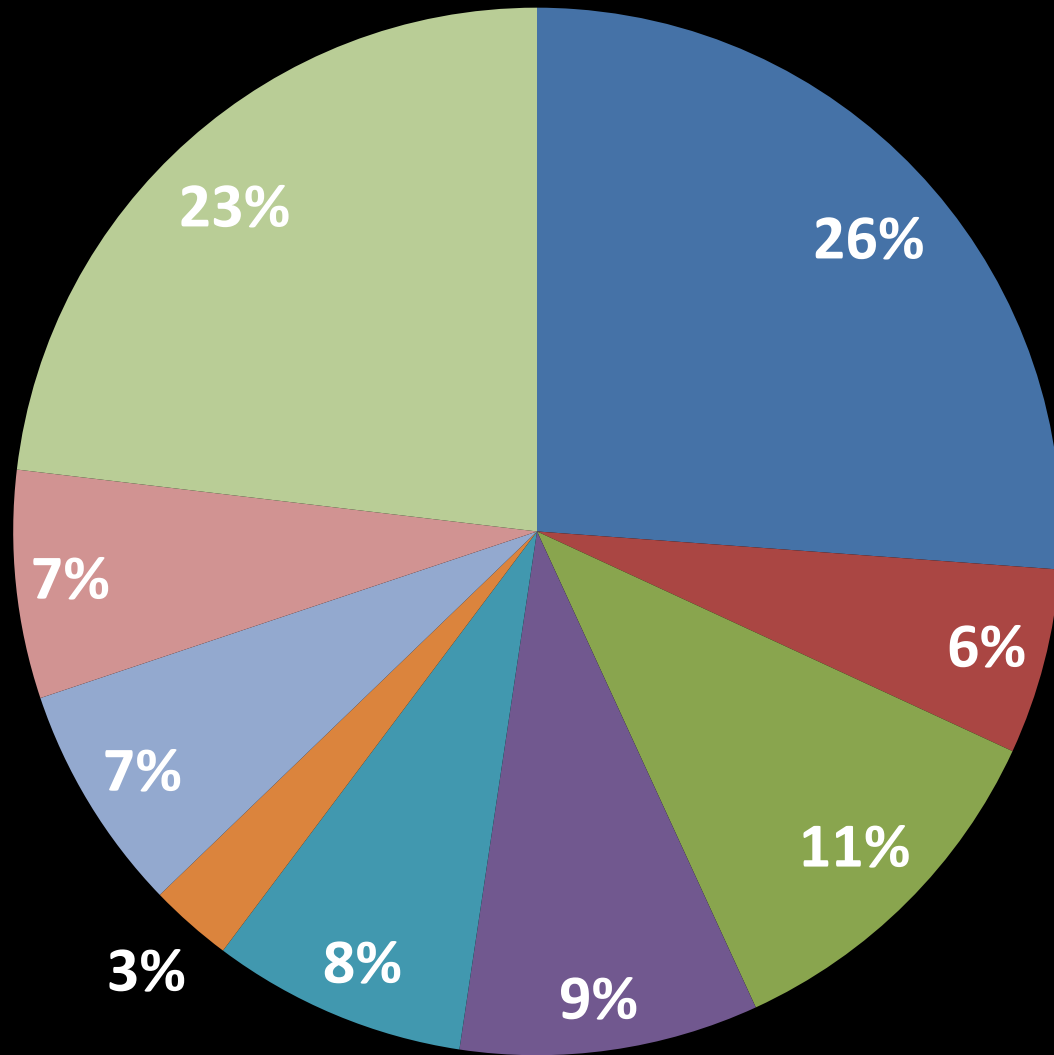

# Opportunities

- Growing number and scale of CCA interventions on the ground -- **opportunity for learning**
- **Vehicles and enablers** for R&D, demonstration, diffusion available in many priority sectors
- Increasing focus on **policy and planning, South-South** exchange



# Challenges

- **Predictability and availability** of funding – e.g. to move from pilots to scale, to maintain resilient infrastructure
- Continued **need to validate** CCA technologies
- **Governance, political and cultural** barriers persist and need to be addressed in their specific context
