Draft provisional agenda for the TEC-CTCN Advisory Board joint session

<p>At the UN Climate Change Conference in Belém, Brazil in November 2025, Parties adopted the Belém Technology Implementation Programme, which shall strengthen support for the implementation of technology priorities identified by developing countries and address the challenges identified in the first periodic assessment of the Technology Mechanism.</p> <p>At the same conference Parties also decided to extend the term of the Climate Technology Centre (CTC) until the end of 2041, adopted revised functions of the CTC, and agreed to launch the selection process of the new host of the CTC.</p> <p>This joint session of the Technology Executive Committee (TEC) and the Advisory Board of the Climate Technology Centre and Network (CTCN) aims to share latest information on the work of the TEC and the CTCN and provide guidance for the implementation of the joint work programme of the Technology Mechanism for 2023–2027.</p>

At their last joint session in September 2025, the TEC and the CTCN Advisory Board agreed to develop an AI Climate Application Hub in partnership with the Digital Public Goods Alliance (DPGA).
