1. Katowice Climate Package – the implementation guidelines for the Paris Agreement



Parties overcame difficult political and complex technical issues to agree the Katowice Climate Package at COP24

- **Procedures and mechanisms** that makes the PA operational
- Respects of the **different capabilities and socio-economic realities** of each country
- **Foundation for ever-increasing ambition** with respect to climate action.



The **Katowice package** contains operational guidance on:

- Information about **domestic mitigation and other climate goals and activities** to provide in the NDCs;
- Communication about **efforts to adapt to climate impacts**;
- Rules for functioning of the **Transparency Framework**;
- **Committee to facilitate implementation of the PA** and promote compliance with the obligations undertaken under the Agreement;
- Conduction the **Global Stocktake** of overall progress towards the aims of the PA;
- Assessment of progress on the **development and transfer of technology**;
- Provision of advance information on **financial support to developing countries** and the process for establishing new targets on finance

2. COP outcomes on technology development and transfer

Joint annual report of the TEC and the CTCN for 2018

- Encouraged the TEC and the CTCN to **enhance their collaboration, including to ensure the coherence and synergy of their work**;
- Noted with appreciation the enhanced engagement and collaboration of the TEC, CTCN and GCF on innovation and collaborative RD&D, and **encouraged their continued and enhanced collaboration**;
- Encouraged the TEC and CTCN to **continue reporting on the monitoring and evaluation of the impact of their activities and to include information on tracking of progress and on methodologies used**;
- Invited the TEC to continue **enhancing its communication and outreach strategy** with a view to expanding the reach of its outputs to NDEs and other regional stakeholders.



Linkages between the Technology Mechanism and the Financial Mechanism

- Invited the CTCN and GCF to continue enhancing collaboration, wherein the services and expertise of the CTCN can be used **to strengthen proposals seeking support under the Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme of the GCF**;
- Invited developing country Parties to seek support from the CTCN to **develop and submit technology-related projects**, including those resulting from TNAs and from the technical assistance of the CTCN, **to the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism for implementation.**

Review of the effective implementation of the CTCN

- Invited **Parties, NDEs and the UNEP as host of the CTCN**, in collaboration with the UNIDO and the Advisory Board of the CTCN, **to implement the relevant recommendations of the review** when implementing their further activities relevant to the work of the CTCN;
- Invited **the operating entities of the Financial Mechanism to consider implementing the relevant recommendations of the review** when implementing their further activities relevant to the work of the CTCN.
