#### Note on changes in figures 2025-2026:

Knowledge products: Input to SCF on draft guidance, Buildings & Infrastructure (2025 & 2026), AI (2025 & 2026) Regional events: NDE Forum but not other events in the region where TEC participated (LT-LEDS, GCF regional structured dialogue)

Inputs and preparatory work: AI

Engagement with bodies: Ocean Dialogue, Gender Dialogue, GCF annual meetings – does not include other ad-hoc invitations (MWP, Just Transition dialogue)



## **Budget for implementation of TEC activities in 2025**

- Approved biennium budget 2024-2025 <u>does not provide</u> for any consultancies and workshops/dialogues/events of TEC work supported from core budget
  - Supplementary funding is required for all anticipated publication/ knowledge products and dialogues/workshops/events in 2024-2025
  - TEC budget is part of SB-200-003 MOI Constituted bodies project
  - Al project is part of SB-400-003 MOI Enhanced engagement project
- For 2025 the budget for implementing all TEC activities (including those in the AI workplan):
  - Estimated around USD 1 million
  - 3 full-time staff: 2 full-time staff supporting various TEC activities, 1 fulltime staff coordinating and supporting activities of AI workplan, work of the activity group and joint taskforce, partnership development
  - All TEC deliverables anticipated in 2025, including one meeting of the TEC
  - Additional deliverables agreed at this TEC29



## **Resources available to undertake the work**

- **Support by UNIDO** for continuing 2024 activities in 2025 (TNA energy sector guidebook, AI technical paper)
- In-kind/expertise contribution from:
  - Global ABC and MIT Policy Lab for Buildings & infrastructure
  - UNEP-CCC for TNA energy sector guidebook

## **Anticipated challenges**

- Other work to be delivered in 2025 (NSI, TNA, Incubators & accelerators, AI, Industry, additional deliverables agreed at this meeting) funding is not secured or willing partners to support/lead have not been found
- Soliciting partnership requires capacity/time of staff that would have been otherwise used to support TEC activities
- Continuing heavy load for supporting intergovernmental process which requires significant time capacity of the secretariat in 2025



# **TEC consideration**

- TEC may wish to consider **revisiting its planned activities** (e.g. review deliverables, re-prioritizing, defer to future, etc.). For example:
  - Defer thematic dialogue on NSI that is due to be held at TEC 30
  - Reconsider the whole package of NSI activities including deliverables up to 2027, taking into account what has been delivered so far (dissemination vs. more knowledge products).
- TEC may wish to ask the activity groups, supported by the secretariat, to undertake preliminary review of activities in 2025-2026 that have multiple deliverables and provide proposals at TEC 30 on how to approach the work, taking into account comments expressed by members at TEC 29, availability of resources and partner organizations to lead the work.
- TEC to continue **soliciting in-kind support** of expert organizations working in the similar areas of work.
